Dear Fathers, ALCP/OSS

Greetings to you all and thanking God for the good health and the life of each one of you.

1. Sabuko Formation House.

As we know Sabuko Formation house not only is for the first year of formation but basically to know that it is the MOTHER HOUSE of our Society, a place where all the activities of the Society were taking place and until now it is so though others are now moved i.e. General Office, Provincial Office, second year of formation, etc. However, with its importance, the first year of formation is taking place here. Together we had annual retreats for our seminarians taking place here but with the number we have at the moment and the rooms we found it impossible to continue doing it at Sabuko. As from this year the annual retreat of our seminarians will be taking place at the ALCP/OSS-Holy Spirit Fathers Formation House, Morogoro (formally titled Holy Spirit College). Secondly, we had rooms where our Priests could sleep during holidays, during annual retreat and also our visitors. We have managed to make major renovation in this house and have ten (10) self-contained rooms good enough to be used by our Priests who are coming for the annual retreats and the like. We feel this will continue to make us in good position with regard to our various activities of the Society which takes place at the Provincial house and Mother House, Sabuko.

2. Bernhard Bendel Formation House, Molangi.

This house started in 1998 with one small new building and one old house which was there on this farm when we got this land. In 2001 the second building for formation started with one floor. At the moment we found that it is necessary to make some renovations apart from other reasons there is a good number of members coming for the second year of formation (Novitiate) i.e. year 2019/2020 they were 14 and this year 2020/2021 they are 12. We have managed to renovate the first building of formation and we are continuing with the second building of formation. Also we are thinking of bringing to life the work started of building a grotto at this place. Please your contribution will be of great help for your Society.

3. ALCP/OSS-Holy Spirit Fathers Formation House, Morogoro.

This house started in 1998 and per today is the only House of formation we have as a Province where our seminarians are formed and make their philosophical and theological studies at the Jordan University College in Morogoro. With a good number of seminarians we are obliged to

make some extensions, amendments of the previous plans of building in order to have enough rooms for our seminarians and formators. This year they had their first annual retreat here. It is a place where we encourage our members to visit often when they come for holidays and encourage our young brothers and as you visit you see what you can advice and contribute.


